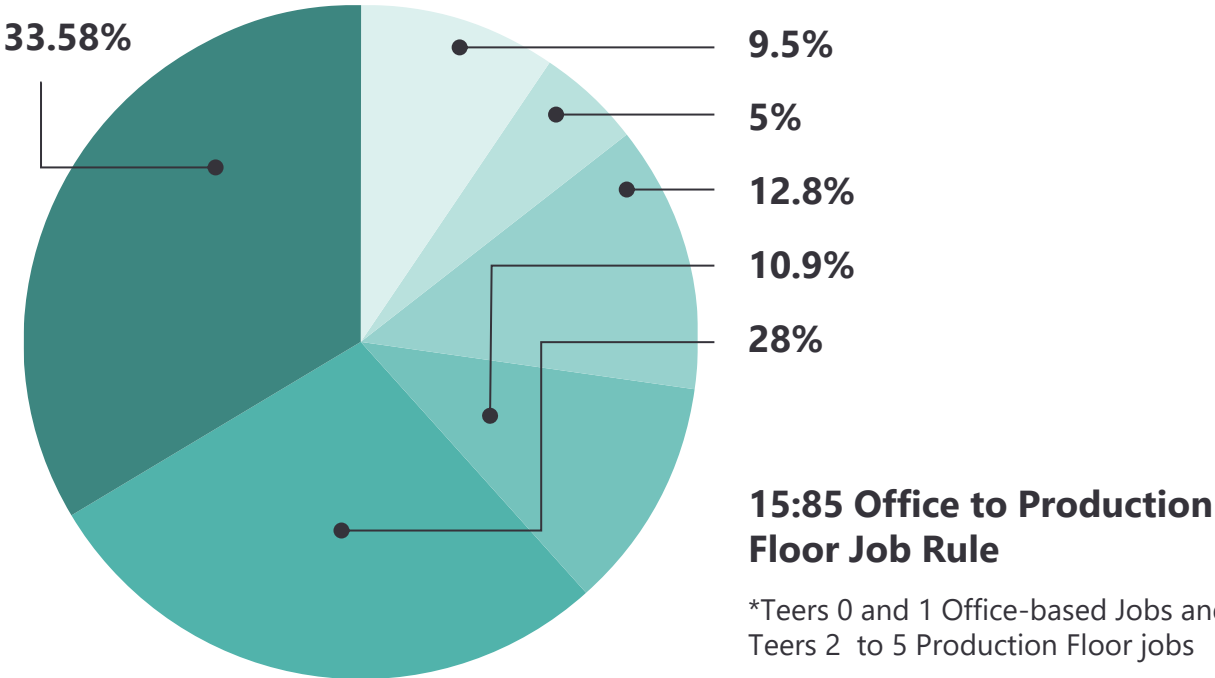


# Types of Employment in the Food and Beverage Processing Industry



- TEER 0** (management occupations) – 9.5% of Employment within Food and Beverage Processing
- TEER 1** (Occupations that usually require a university degree) – 5.0% of Employment within Food and Beverage Processing
- TEER 2** (Occupations that usually require a college diploma or apprenticeship training of 2 years or more or supervisory occupations) – 12.8% of Employment within Food and Beverage Processing
- TEER 3** (Occupations that usually require a college diploma or apprenticeship training of less than 2 years or more than 6 months of on-the-job training) – 10.9% of Employment within Food and Beverage Processing
- TEER 4** (Occupations that usually require a high school diploma or several weeks of on-the-job training) – 28.0% of Employment within Food and Beverage Processing
- TEER 5** (Occupations that usually need short-term work demonstration and no formal education) – 33.8% of Employment within Food and Beverage Processing
